In 2020, in the Brereton Report, it became clear that soldiers from the same unit had murdered people, including children in Afghanistan. And how it was largely ignored by the Australian media and peace movement. To this day i still have PTSD, panic attacks and Generalised Anxiety Disorder stemming from this event. What damage have Australian Special Forces, trained by and with the US Special Forces done around the world?
